A-Z of Churchyard Conservation

O is for Owl

Tawny Owl is the most likely owl to be heard in the churchyard. It will nest in the church building or in large trees and roost in winter in evergreen trees. The male makes the familiar 'hooo-hoo-hooo' sound while the female replies with a coarse 'ke-wick' call. In days gone by the Tawny Owl was seen as the harbinger of death because it often called from churchyard trees in the dark months of autumn and winter when many people died.
